

YOUR JOURNEY TO JESUS Bible Study Notes

EXODUS 29 — Aaron and His Sons Consecrated

Welcome to our Tuesday Night Bible Study. Tonight we begin our study of Exodus 29. In this chapter, God provides specific instructions to Moses concerning the consecration of Aaron and his sons, and how sacrifices and offerings were to be brought before the Lord. During this study, we will read and discuss the principles of holiness, sacrifice, the greatness of God's own sacrifice, and God's desire to dwell among His people. The topics we will cover in this chapter include:

- The Consecration of the Priests (verses 1-4)
- Aaron and His Sons Dressed in Holy Garments (verses 5-9)
- The Sin Offering (verses 10-14)
- The Burnt Offering (verses 15-20)
- The Consecration Offering (verses 21-25)
- The Wave Offering (verses 26-30)
- The Food of the Priests (verses 31-37)
- The Daily Offerings (verses 38-46

Through obedience to the ordinances of the Lord our God; we acknowledge, honor, and glorify His holy standards, and we are called to live in purity and reverence before Him. The promises God made to us in His Holy Word is a powerful and constant reminder of:

- His love and compassion for us.
- His grace and mercy extended to us.
- His desire to commune and dwell with us.

Let us not forget the purpose to which we were call, and the amazing sacrifice that was made so that we could become God's Holy people; the children of the Most-High God (<u>John 1:10-13</u>; <u>Psalms 82:1-9</u>; <u>John 10:34-38</u>; <u>2 Corinthians 6:14-18</u>; <u>2 Corinthians 5:14-21</u>). We will also be discussing the offerings made to the Lord and the requirements concerning those offerings;

the burnt offering, the grain offering, the sin offering, etc. (<u>Leviticus 6:1-7</u>). Additional verses are included below to increase your clarity and understanding concerning the offerings.

The Grain/Peace Offering

- Leviticus 2:1-16 (The grain offering)
- <u>Leviticus 6:14-23</u> (The law of the grain offering)
- <u>Leviticus 3:1-17</u> (The peace offering)
- Leviticus 7:11-21 (The law of the peace offering)

The Sin Offering

- <u>Leviticus 4:1-35</u> (The sin offering)
- Leviticus 6:24-30 (The law of the sin offering)

The Burnt Offering

- <u>Leviticus 1:1-17</u> (The burnt offering)
- Leviticus 6:8-13 (The law of the burnt offering)

The Wave Offering

- Leviticus 7:28-38 (The portion for Aaron and his sons)
- <u>Leviticus 23:15-22</u> (The feast of weeks)

The Trespass Offering

- <u>Leviticus 5:1-19</u> (If a person sins in hearing the utterance of an oath, and is a witness, whether he has seen or known of the matter; if he does not tell it, he bears guilt.
- <u>Leviticus 7:1-10</u> (The law of the trespass offering)
- <u>Leviticus 7:22-27</u> (The fat and blood may not be eaten)

The Garments, Washing, and Anointing of Christ

- John 19:1-6 (Rather than a turban, our High Priest received a crown of thorns)
- Matthew 27:27-31 (They stripped Him and put a scarlet robe on Him)
- Matthew 27:35 (They crucified Him and divided His garments, casting lots)
- <u>Luke 7:36-38</u> (His feet were washed)
- Matthew 26:6-13; Luke 7:39-46; John 11:1-3; John 12:1-8 (He was anointed)

The Greatness of the New Priest

- Hebrews 7:20-28 (For such a High Priest was fitting for us)
- <u>Hebrews 9:23-28</u> (He appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself)

- <u>2 Corinthians 5:21</u> (He became sin who knew no sin. Therefore, when He came into the world, He said; sacrifice and offering You did not desire, but a body You prepared for Me).
- Zechariah 2:10-13 (I am coming, and I will dwell in your midst)
- <u>Jeremiah 29:11-14</u> (I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope)
- Revelation 21:1-8 (All things made new, and the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them)
- John 14:19-23 (Because I live, you will live also)
- Romans 6:1-14 (If we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection)
- Revelation 3:20-22 (I stand at the door and knock)

A Higher Calling In Christ

- <u>1 Peter 1:3-5</u> (His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope)
- <u>1 Peter 1:13-25</u> (Gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest *your* hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ)
- Colossians 3:12-17 (As the elect of God, holy and beloved; let us behave accordingly)
- Hebrews 12:1-15 (Let us run with endurance the race that is set before us)
- Romans 8:26-30 (All things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose)
- Proverbs 3:1-12 (Do not forget my law, but let your heart keep my commands)
- <u>2 Corinthians 5:17-19</u> (Now all things *are* of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation)
- 1 Peter 2:9-10 (You are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation)
